Update on the Leconfield Parish Council Website

By the time that you are reading this our new Leconfield Parish council website should be up and running. When you login to our current website you will be taken automatically to the updated version.

Our website has been updated so that we can improve our communication with our communities. You will be able to contact us by e-mail and receive e-mails about the latest news (if you subscribe to this facility). Over the next few months we hope to develop the site further into a useful local resource. We will provide information regarding Parish Council meetings, local history, a list of community groups and activities, and news about events happening locally. If you have any comments you wish to make or suggestions on how we can improve the website please let us know.

There is a "What's Going On" page on the updated website and we will start to populate the calendar month by month with events taking place in the Village Hall and Recreation Club. This will include groups who meet regularly and one-off events such as parties. Once we are sure that it is working properly we hope to add "on-line booking" to the calendar. This will then replace the current system of booking through the Recreation Cub. We are currently reviewing the terms and conditions of booking, including the introduction of a booking form and a "Frequently Asked Questions" (FAQ) section. This will make it easier to make a booking knowing what we can offer within our current facilities and what it would cost. We will let you know through the newsletter and social media

when the booking system will be going live and all current bookings will be automatically transferred to the new system.

Using the small lottery grant of £2500 and a donation of paint by Crown, we have managed to transform the space!

All the lights in the area have also been replaced, and a new hard floor will be fitted in the New Year. Tables and chairs have been purchased along with new café and play equipment. A big THANK YOU to Lisa Harris and the young volunteers who have made this transformation possible on such a small budget, and Kate Capes for purchasing all the equipment.

We are hoping to be granted further funding to provide stay and play sessions for the young, various new activities for our older residents based in the café area along with a monthly weekend Community cafe session in the village hall. Although we are still finalising our plans for when the café can open, we are now aiming for February or early March 2022. Thank you to

Each session will include a combination of teaching/discussion, at least one practical tasks or tools relating to the session theme and will end with approximately half an hour of relaxation exercises. You will be led through different breathing, movement and mindful exercises which will allow you to calm your busy mind, become less anxious and more mindful and fully relax both physically and mentally. There will also be an opportunity for you to have a break and refreshments during the session.

My Mindful Play are play sessions delivered in 6 week blocks, where adult and child will enjoy engaging together in a series of fun mindful play-based activities, all based upon a carefully selected age appropriate story book.

The carefully planned activities will use mindful play techniques to:

- develop your child's emotional understanding and resilience,
- help your child develop greater self awareness and social skills
- teach your child easy to apply self regulation and relaxation skills
- provide your child with tools that will support their mental and physical health throughout life.

Each My Mindful Play session include a host of activities which will encompass our five key concepts:

Mindful play, exploration, and discovery Mindful breathing Mindful movement Mindful senses Mindful language and communication
