1	Election of Chair - Clerk requested nominations for the Chair. Cllr Haslam nominated Cllr Garbutt and all Cllrs in agreement. Cllr Garbutt elected as Chair.
2	Election of Vice Chair - Chair nominated Cllr Robinson for Vice Chair. Cllr Haslam seconded the nomination. Cllr Robinson elected as Vice -chair.
3	Chair approved the minutes of the meeting dated 13/05/24 and agreed and signed as a true record.
4	<p>Chairmans annual report for year ending 31/03/25 – Chair reported on our busy year with the refurbishment of the Village Hall, our securing of further grants to fund providing CCTV to help with the security of the building and also iPads, laptops and a TV to support the Youth Club. Secured new equipment for the Bowls Club, installed a Muga Goal and Basket Ball Courts.</p> <p>We have secured 3 new football teams. We have improved access to defibrillators now having 4 units in the Parish Including Scorbrough and Arram.,. Focus was on flooding issues in 24/25. We also had fun holding a BouncyFest and more recently a Community Day.</p> <p>The PC worked with DST and successfully reinstated streetlights on Grange Road.</p>

6	Thanks were given to Cllr Cockin (resigned April 2025) for her work as RFO in 2025 during which the refurbishment of the village hall required multiple transactions The Chair gave a summary of the Accounts for the financial year 2024-5. Key points included large spend due to refurbishment and the increase of £20k in assets due to purchases.
